



## HUD's FY 2016 Continuum of Care on Homelessness' Competition released June 29

Each year, the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) releases a competitive funding opportunity to Continuums of Care (CoC) nationally working to end homelessness. UCS is Johnson County's CoC lead agency and submits the application annually on behalf of local members. In FY 2015, \$675,000 was awarded to members of Johnson County's CoC to support 10 programs.

The FY 2016 CoC application has been released and is due September 14, 2016 to HUD. To view the notice, click [here](#).
