KanCare Passes Out of the Senate Health and Welfare Committee

As soon as Monday, March 27, the bill expanding KanCare will go to the floor.

Expanding eligibility will improve the health and economic well-being of Kansas families. Currently, KanCare income eligibility levels are as low as 33% of poverty, which is an income of \$6,600 per year for a family of three. Expanding KanCare

eligibility provides an additional 150,000 Kansans with health insurance coverage, including 9,500 people in Johnson County alone.
