

Johnson County Population Projections, 2014-2064





Estimated that Johnson County >65 Population will grow more than 300% by 2064

Distribution of Race / Ethnicity by Age Group



U.S. Percent Increase 2005-2015



Immigrants: 21%





30% of Jobs Pay Less Than \$15/hr. in Johnson County





Insufficient Income Requires Difficult Choices


What it Takes to Raise A Family – Example Single Parent with Two Children







The Health and Well-Being of Johnson County

The Health and Well-Being of Johnson County Mental Health

A Community-Wide Issue

- 20% of the US population have a diagnosable mental illness
 - 115,000 Johnson County residents
- 2.6% of adults suffer with a severe and persistent mental illness
 - 11,200 Johnson County residents
- 5-9% of children experience a severe emotional disturbance
 - 7,200 –13,000 Johnson County residents
- 7.5% of adults and youth have a significant, ongoing problem with substance abuse/use
 - 36,000 Johnson County residents

The cost of untreated or inadequately treated mental illness


- Increased hospitalization or institutional care
- Lost jobs
- Family breakup
- School failure
- Premature Death
- Increased suicide rate
- Increased Involvement in the criminal justice system
- Increased incarceration




The Health and Well-Being of Johnson County Child Care Availability and Costs

Early Head Start Spots Available (Per 100 Children Age 0-3)




Head Start Spots Available (Per 100 Children Ages 3 and 4)
