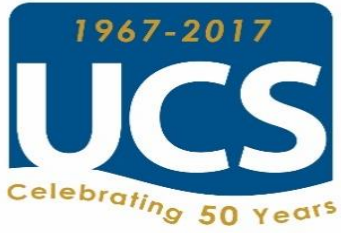

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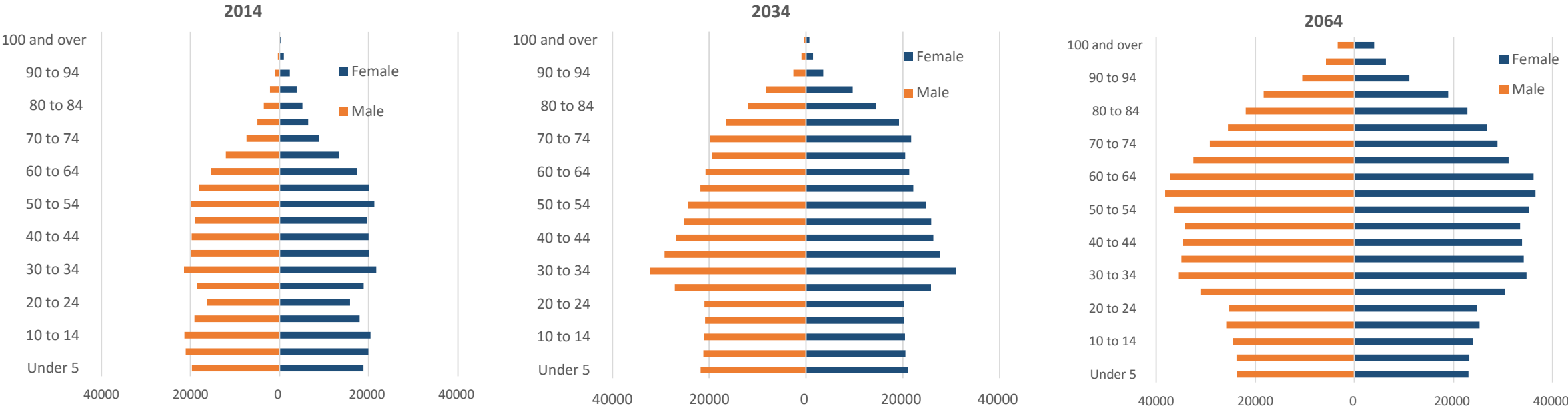

## Johnson County Population Projections, 2014-2064

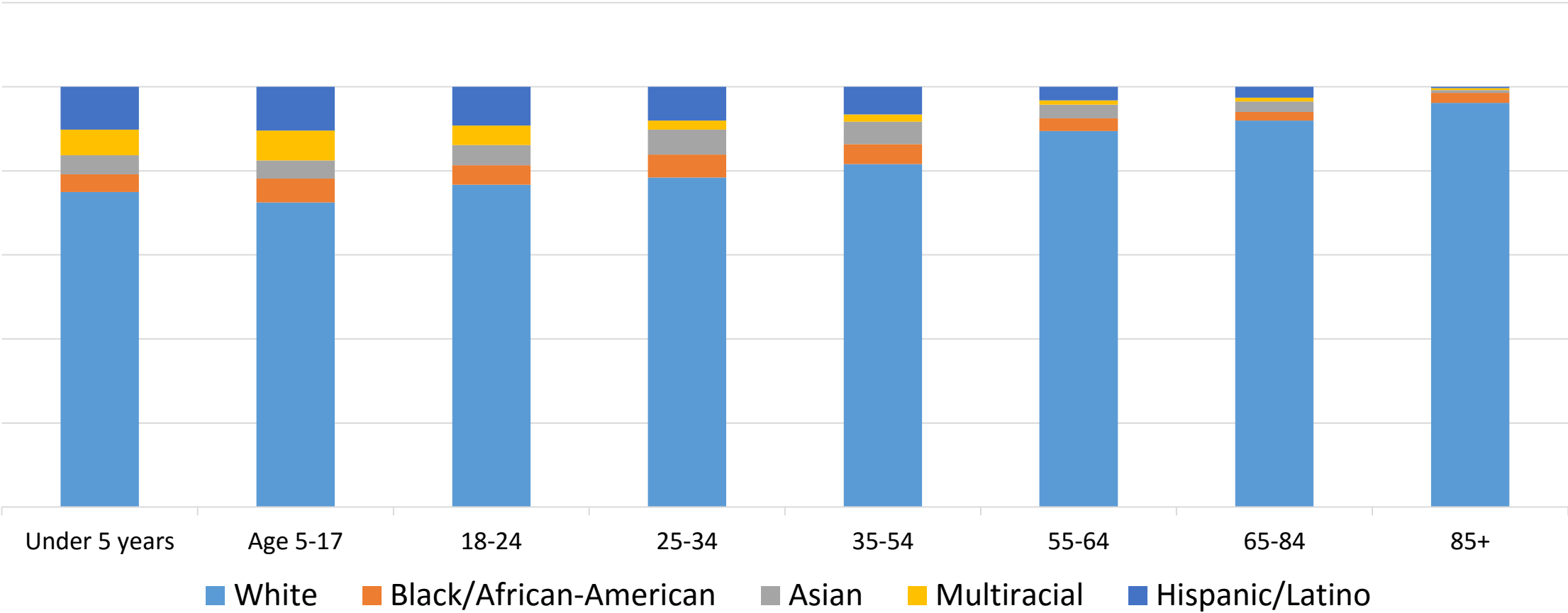


Estimated that Johnson County >65 Population will grow more than 300% by 2064

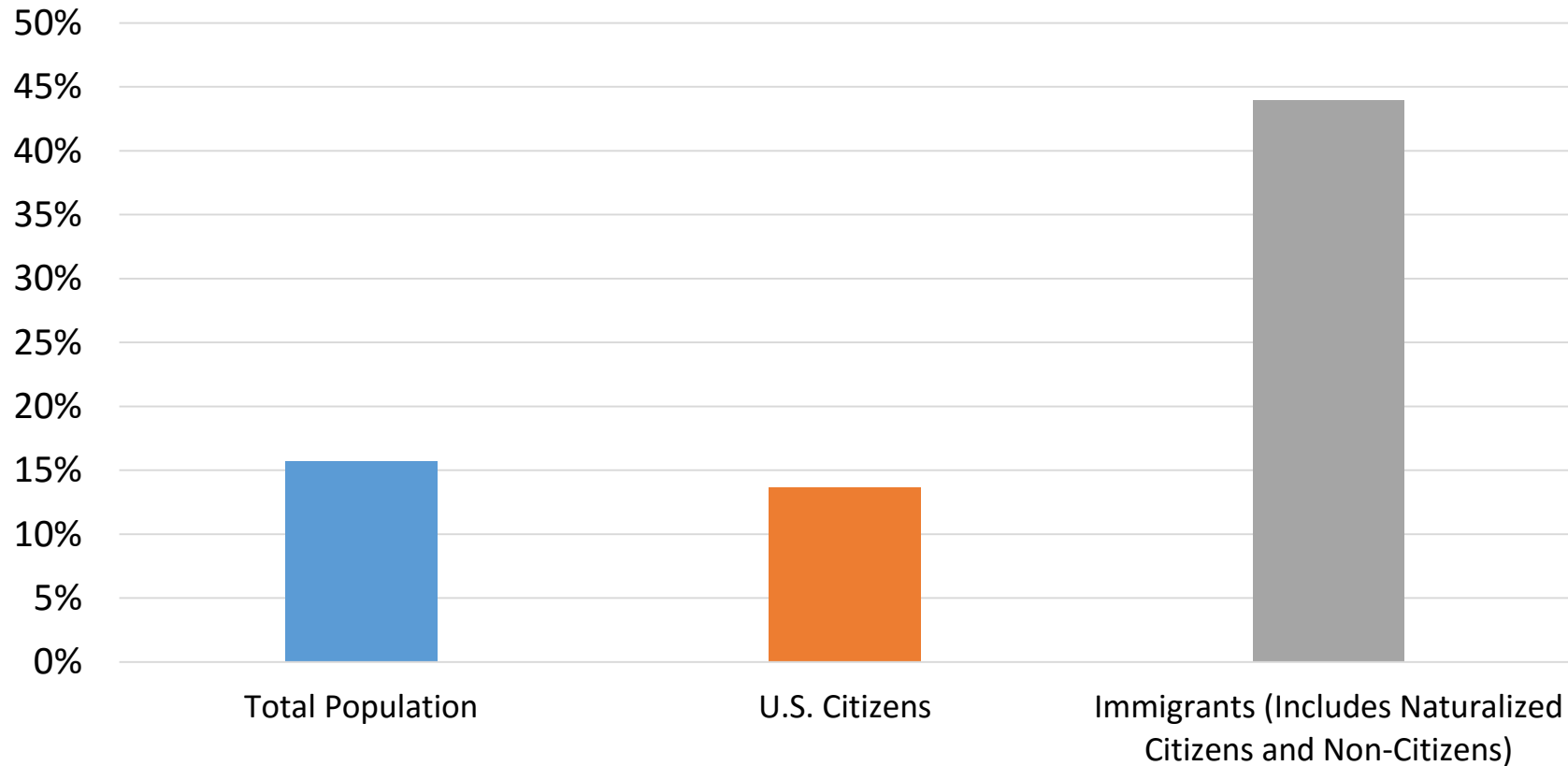
## Distribution of Race /Ethnicity by Age Group

## Percent Change in Population and Immigrants, 2005-2015

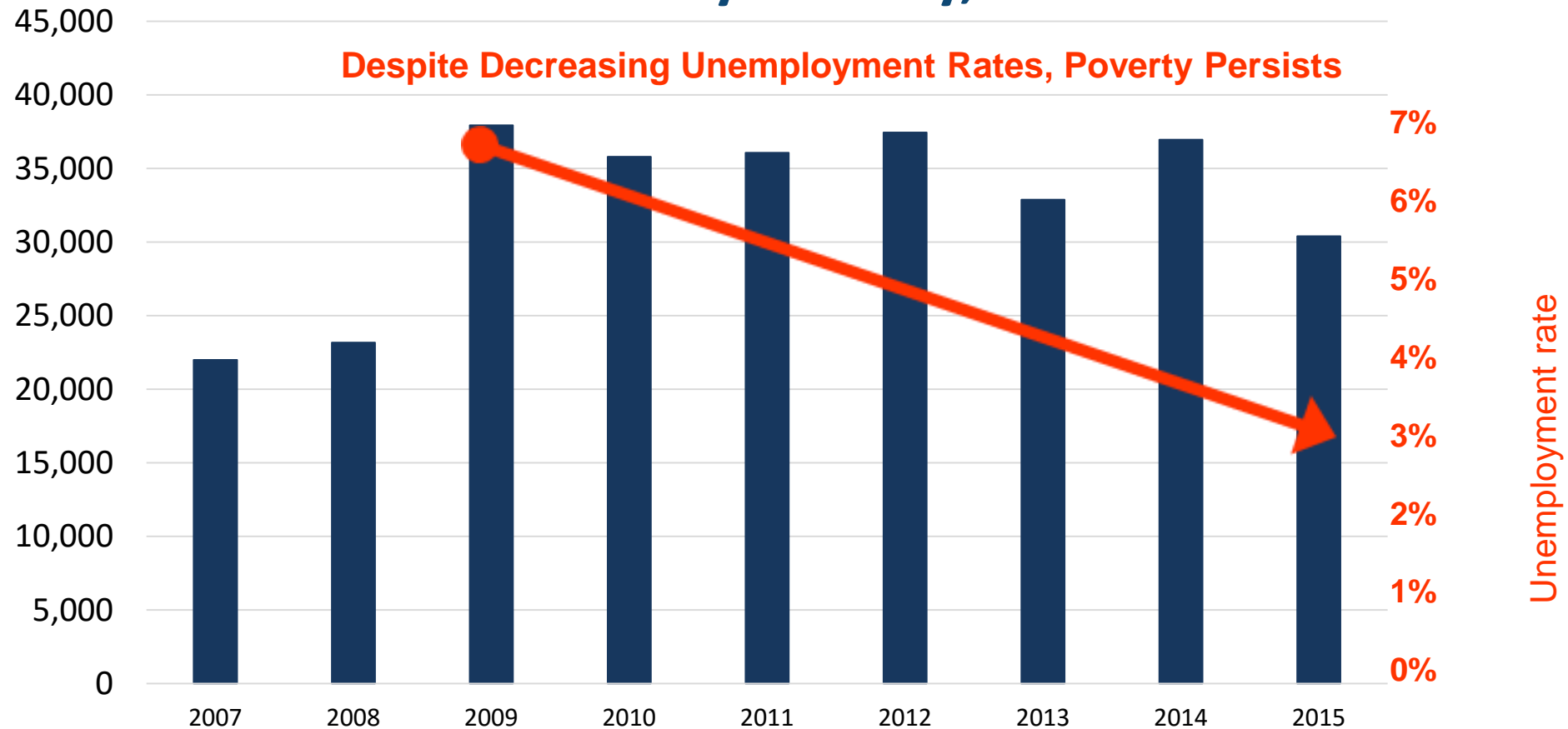


**Kansas Percent Increase 2005-2015**

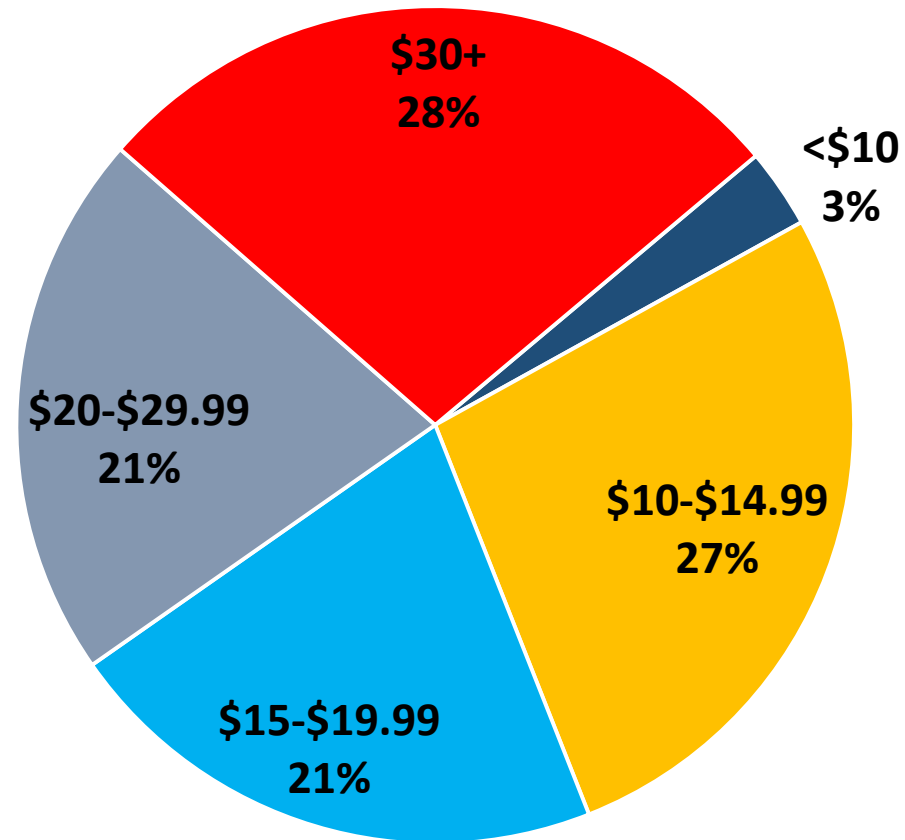
## Johnson County Poverty, 2007 - 2015

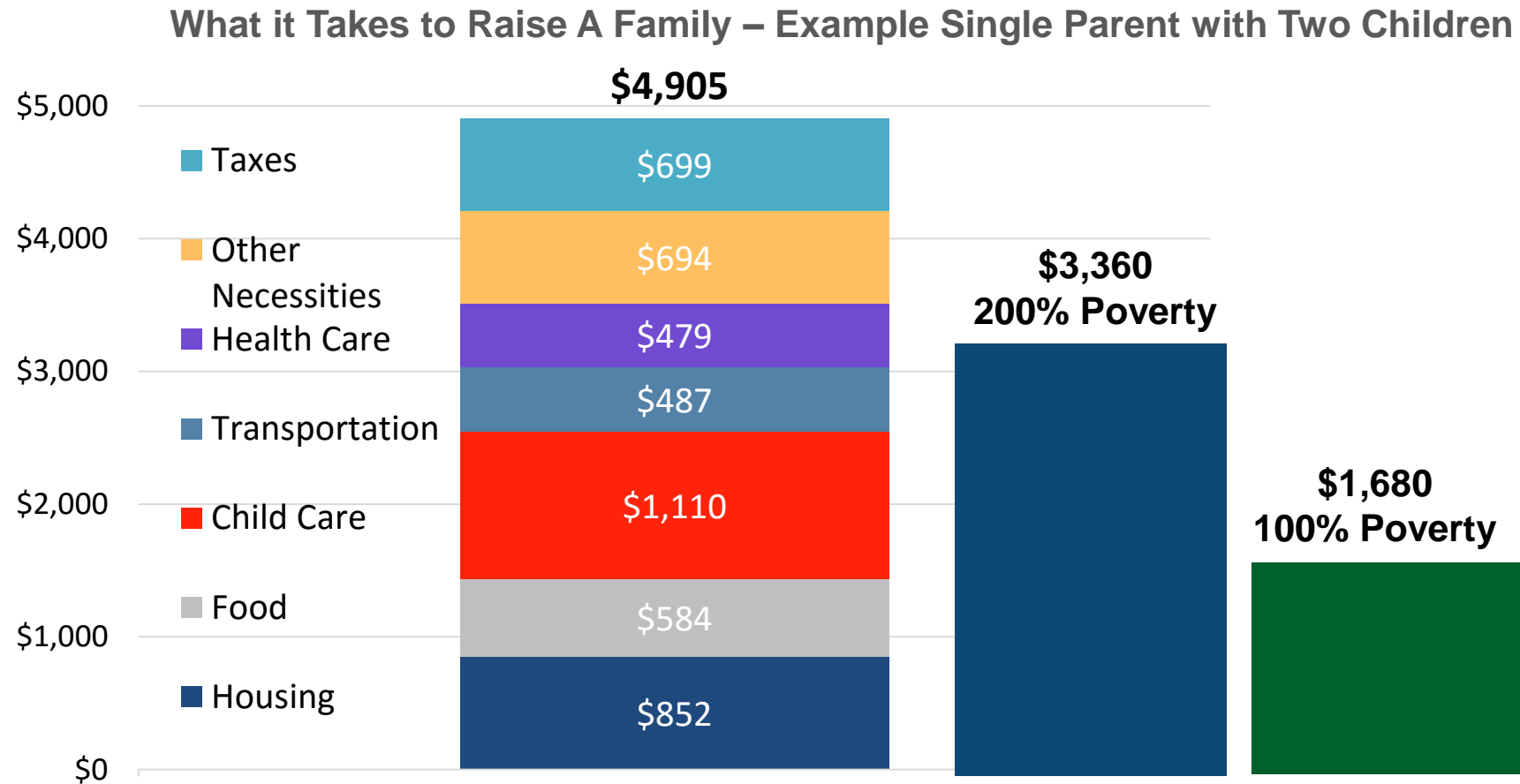

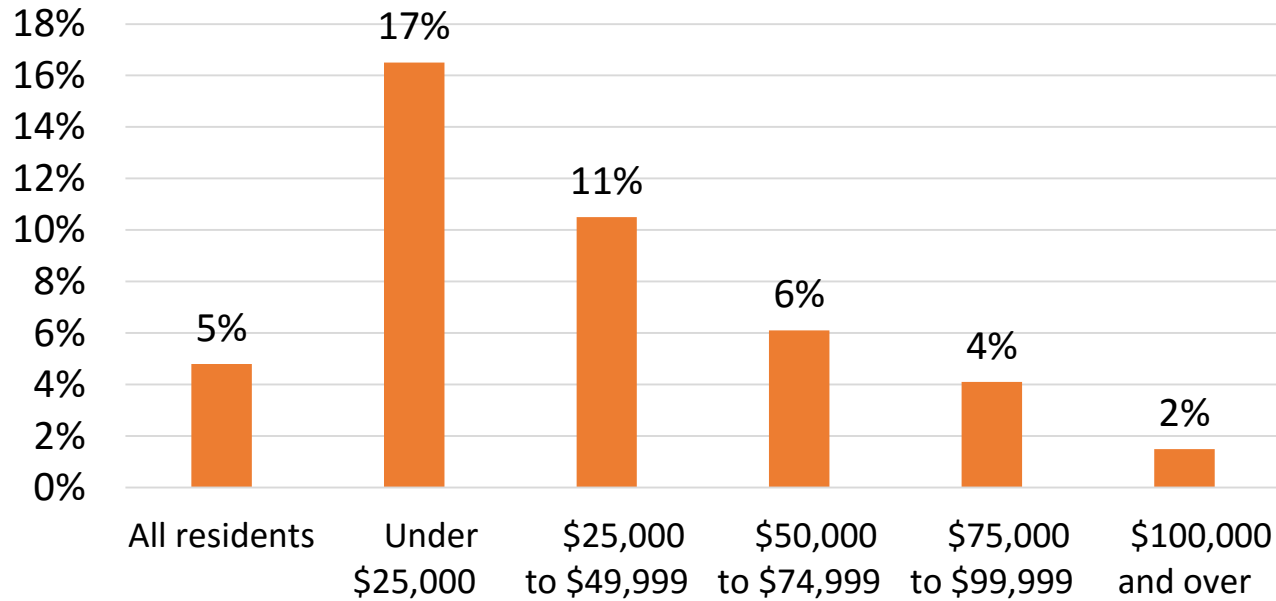


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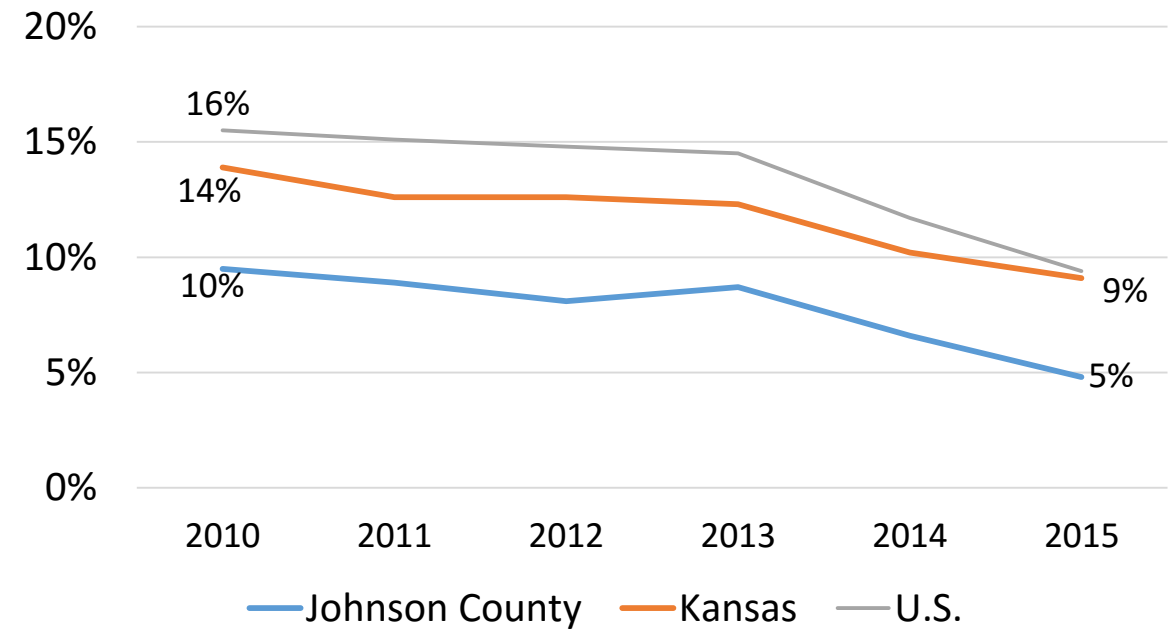

# The Health and Well-Being of Johnson County

## Mental Health

### A Community-Wide Issue

- 20% of the US population have a diagnosable mental illness
  - 115,000 Johnson County residents
- 2.6% of adults suffer with a severe and persistent mental illness
  - 11,200 Johnson County residents
- 5-9% of children experience a severe emotional disturbance
  - 7,200 –13,000 Johnson County residents
- 7.5% of adults and youth have a significant, ongoing problem with substance abuse/use
  - 36,000 Johnson County residents

### The cost of untreated or inadequately treated mental illness

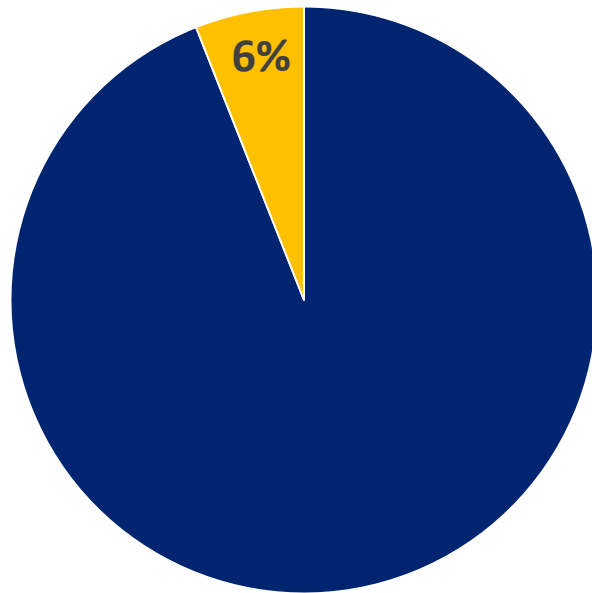
- Increased hospitalization or institutional care
- Lost jobs
- Family breakup
- School failure
- Premature Death
- Increased suicide rate
- Increased Involvement in the criminal justice system
- Increased incarceration

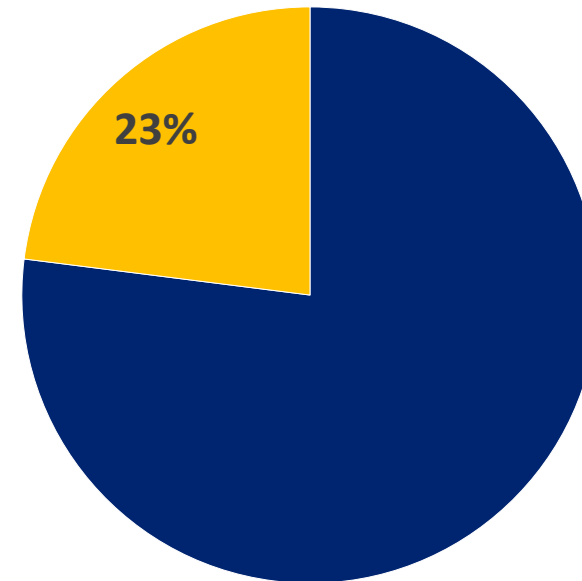

(Per 100 Children Ages 3 and 4)

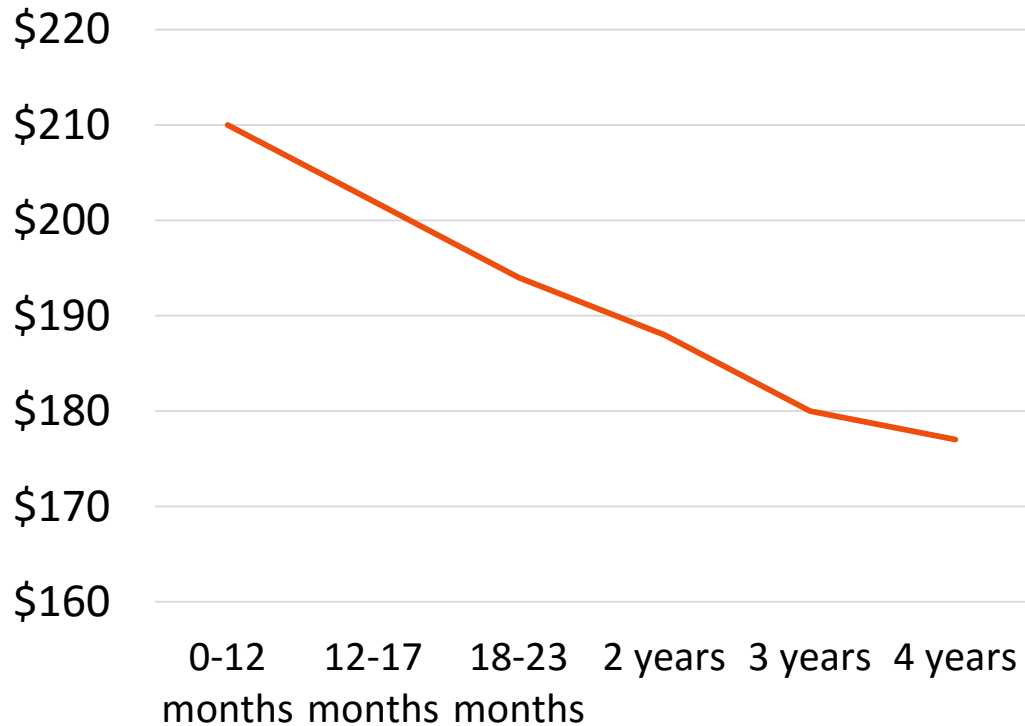

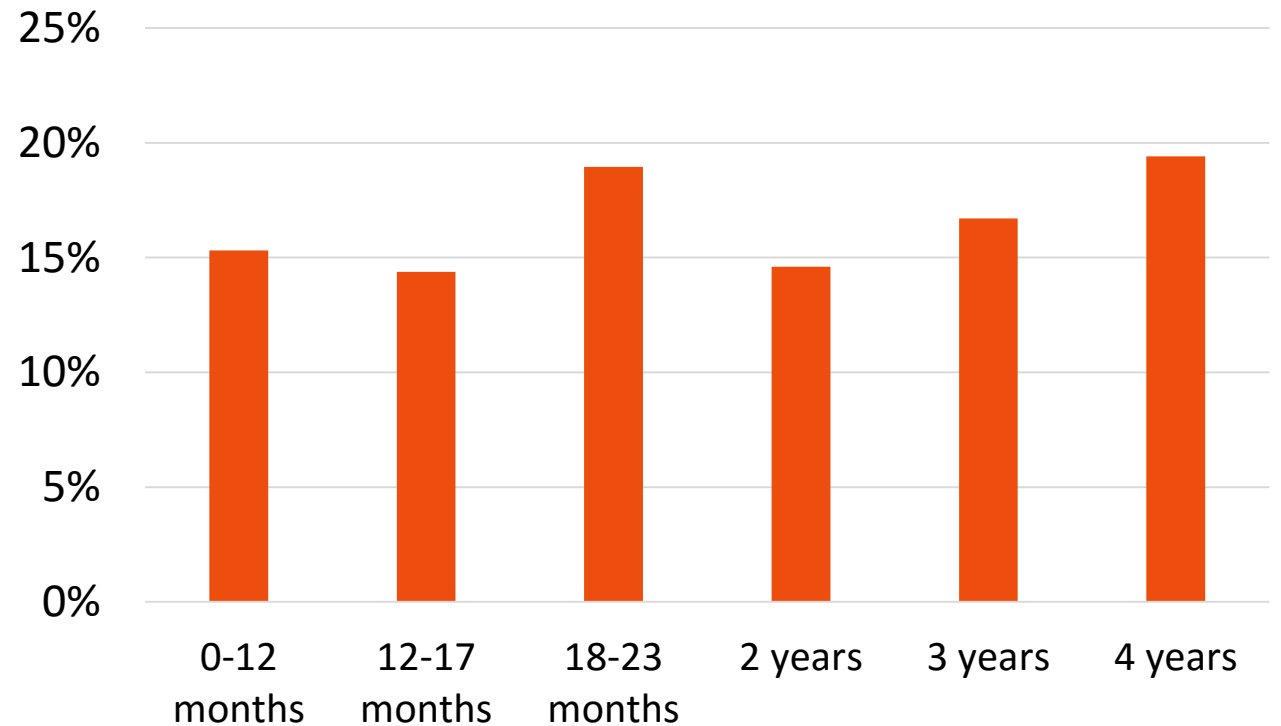
