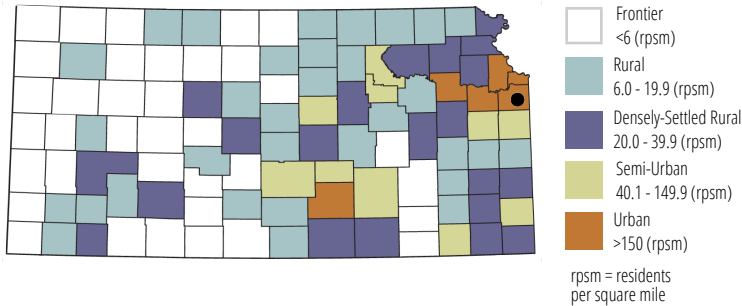

IMMUNIZATIONS

Percent of kindergarteners fully immunized of the 4:3:1:3:3 series at 35 months of age. Current data from 2016-17 school year.

PRENATAL CARE

Percent of live births to mothers who received adequate or adequate-plus prenatal care. Current data from 2017.

LOW BIRTH WEIGHT BABIES

Percent of live births weighing under 5.5 lbs. Current data from 2017.

INFANT MORTALITY

Number of deaths, under age 1, per 1,000 live births. Current rate from 2017.

TEEN VIOLENT DEATHS

Number per 100,000 of 15 to 19-year-olds who died due to suicide, homicide or motor vehicle accident. Current data from 2016.

UNINSURED CHILDREN

Percent of children under 19 with no health insurance coverage. Current data from 2016.

MENTAL HEALTH

Number per 1,000 children under 18 hospitalized for mental health. Current data from 2017.

MEDICAID ENROLLMENT (Not depicted as rate)

Average monthly enrollment of children under 19 in Medicaid. Current data from 2017.

CHIP ENROLLMENT (Not depicted as rate)

Average monthly enrollment of children under 19 in the Children's Health Insurance Program. Current data from 2017.
