youthStart is a collaborative effort in Johnson County in response to a growing number of young adults who experience homelessness.

We provide stable housing through a local landlord who offers an affordable place for the young adults to live.

reStart of Greater Kansas City has secured federal grant funds to pay rent for the young adults rent. In addition they have provided a staff person to help connect these young adults to the community services necessary for self-sufficiency.

Our staff provides coaching in a variety of areas to also enhance life skills and professional skills for life long growth for the young adults we serve.
