

RESOLUTION NO. 9-22-88

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE CITY OF EDGERTON, KANSAS POLICY AGAINST DISCRIMINATION.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Edgerton, Kansas has by resolution numbered 6-12-80 declared it to be the public policy of said city to eliminate discrimination and safeguard the right of any person to sell, purchase, lease, rent, or obtain real property without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Edgerton, Kansas, declares it to be a policy of the City of Edgerton to prevent and eliminate discrimination in all employment relations; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Edgerton, Kansas declares it to be a policy of the City of Edgerton to eliminate and prevent discrimination, segregation, or separation in all places of public accommodations covered by the Kansas Act Against Discrimination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON, KANSAS it is deemed an exercise of the powers of the City of Edgerton, for the protection of the public welfare, prosperity, health and peace of the people of said city:

Section One: That the City of Edgerton re-affirms and re-states its public policy regarding Fair Housing Policy of the City of Edgerton adopted by Resolution 6-12-80.

Section Two: That the Kansas Act Against Discrimination [1988] from the Kansas Commission on Civil Rights is hereby adopted by reference as the public policy of the City of Edgerton.

Section Three: That the City of Edgerton will assist, any person aggrieved by an alleged unlawful employment practice or any alleged unlawful discriminatory practice, by assisting the aggrieved person in filing complaints and contacting the Kansas Commission on Civil Rights.

Any person claiming to have been subjected to any discriminatory practice as defined by this resolution may file a complaint with the assistance of the City of Edgerton to the Kansas Commission on Civil Rights.


Section Four: The provision of this resolution are severable and if any provision, sentence, clause, section or part thereof is held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this resolution or their applica-

tion to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Governing Body that this resolution would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, sentence, clause, section, or part had not been included therein, and if the person or circumstances to which the resolution or any part thereof is inapplicable had been specifically exempted therefrom.

Section Five: A copy of this resolution shall be made available to any person who wishes to see it at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Edgerton, Kansas together with a copy of the Kansas Act Against Discrimination, for viewing during business hours, and photostatic copies of same may be obtained at cost of person requesting same at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Edgerton, Kansas, during normal business hours.

Section Six: This resolution shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.
