The rank and review committee met on Wednesday, October 27 to review and finalize their consensus. For the FY 2021, nine project applications were received and recommended for allocation. Of these, 6 were renewals (3 Rapid Rehousing, 2 Permanent Supportive Housing, 1 CoC planning, and 1 HMIS); 1 application was for a new project; and 1 was for the DV bonus funding opportunity. Using a scoring sheet approved by KS505 CoC Board, committee members scored project applications on program type, program focus, commitment to equity, community responsiveness and coordination, and objective performance measures related to housing stability, income sufficiency, bed utilization and fiscal responsibility that were drawn from each existing organizations’ annual performance reports. KS-505’s annual renewal demand (ARD) -the amount needed to fully fund all existing projects, is \$747,671. Additionally, the CoC is eligible for \$22,666\* for a planning project, up to \$37,777 for CoC bonus to create a new project and \$113,156 for a domestic violence bonus. Project applications were ranked from highest to lowest percentage scores, calculated by dividing the number of total points received by the possible points available. Tier 1 includes projects reflect the grant budgets of all those prioritized up to 100% of the CoC’s ARD or \$747,671, including the reallocation of funds to create a new project. Tier 2 includes requests for the CoC Bonus to fully fund a new project and the DV Bonus. The CoC planning grant is usually not ranked. The Committee made its recommendations to KS505 CoC Board which approved the recommendations on Friday, October 29, 2021.

**Abbreviations and Definitions:**

**ARD** = annual renewal demand, the amount needed to fully fund all existing projects previously funded

**DV** = domestic violence

**HMIS** = Homeless Management Information System

**PSH** = permanent supportive housing program

**RRH** = rapid re-housing program (form of permanent housing)

**TH** = transitional housing program

**Renewal** = project application that was previously funded

**Reallocation** = previously awarded grant funds reallocated to meet a current need due to underperformance, diminished need, or transition to another project type.
