Name of Committee	Role of Committee	Meeting Frequency
Expanding Permanent Housing Options Committee	To increase the availability of permanent housing options for the homeless, very low, and low income residents by building relationships with local landlords and strategic use of private and mainstream housing supports	Quarterly
Gaining/Maintaining Employment and Income Committee	To increase access to household sustaining employment and income, reduce barriers to maintaining employment long term, and to expand soft skills training, targeted job preparation, and employment opportunities for low and very low income residents	Semi-Annually
Data Quality and Performance Measures	To monitor HMIS data quality and completeness, make upgrades to HMIS systems, maintain agreed upon level of data timeliness and accuracy, drill down on systems performance measures to inform planning, and run quarterly reports for review	Semi-Annually
Coordinated Entry Committee	To monitor the effectiveness of coordinated entry and the movement of households off the by-name list by characteristics and housing types being sought; examine trends in housing successes and challenges to inform implementation; raise awareness of and engagement in CE system	Quarterly
Racial and Ethnic Disparities in Homelessness Committee	To understand and modify factors contributing to racial and ethnic disparities in homelessness in order to eliminate them	Quarterly
Rank & Review Committee	To evaluate applications, review project performance, and make recommendations on project application rank order and final funding requests in the CoC combined application for HUD funding, consistent with current HUD guidelines	Aug-Nov
Point in Time Count Committee	To plan and carry out the annual Point in Time Count in late January	Oct-Feb
Lived Experience Advisory Board	Former participants who have received shelter/housing services serve as experts on the homelessness system in Johnson County, provide feedback on service gaps, program design improvements. LEAB members serve on all other CoC Committees and the LEAB co-chairs have a seat on the CoC Board	Every 4 months
Board Development Committee	Subset of CoC Board members responsible for developing nominations for Board Co-Chairs, Secretary and monitoring the board membership list to assure the CoC Board includes members as outlined by the KS-505 Governance Charter	Semi-Annually
