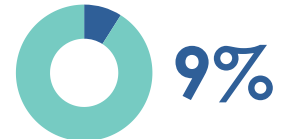

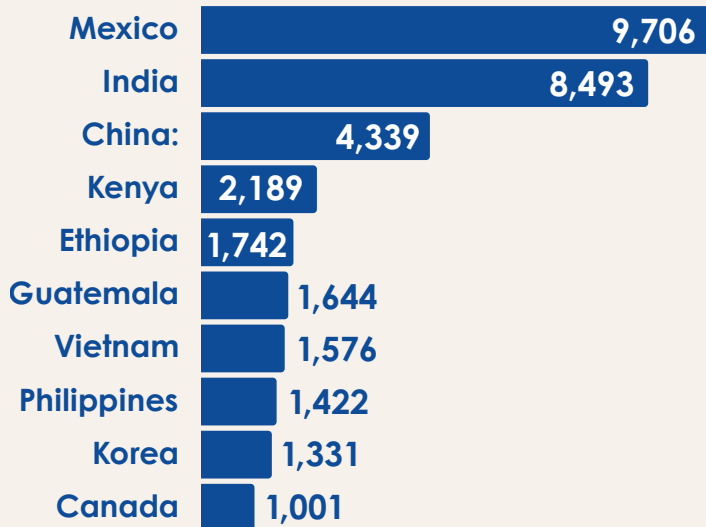

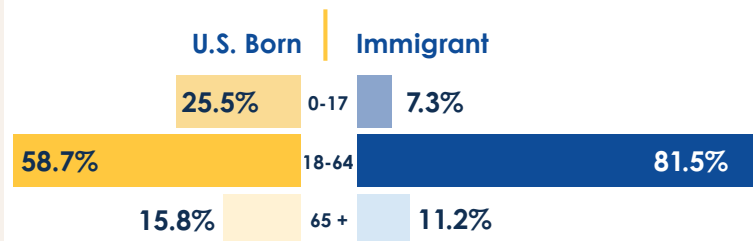

Shares of Population by Age

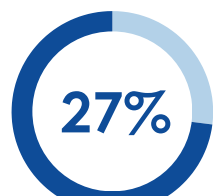

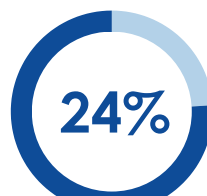


Educational Attainment for Immigrants in Johnson County

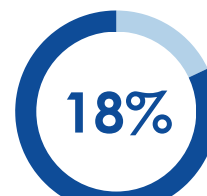

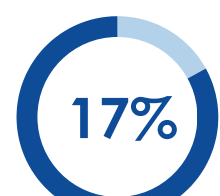

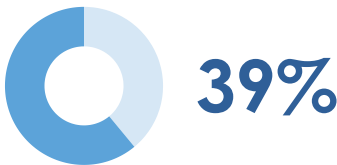
Working Age Population

Immigrants in Johnson County are

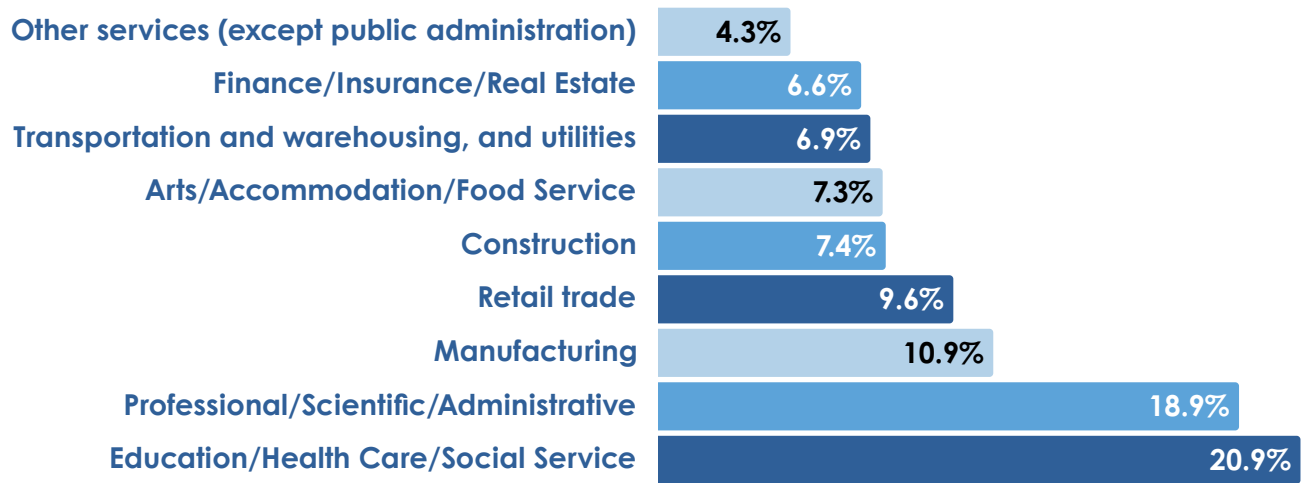


more likely to be of working age than their U.S.-born counterparts

The immigrant working-age population is **52% female** and **48% male**.

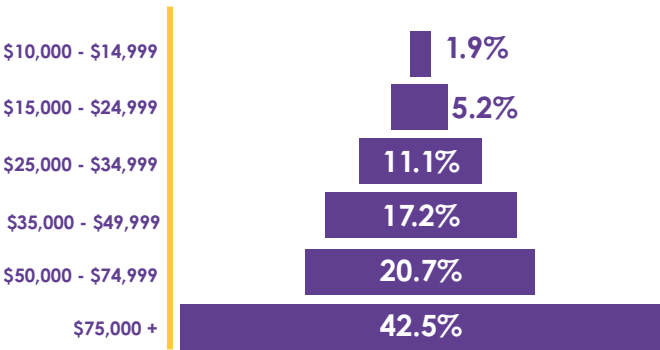


Percent of Immigrants Working in Key Industries in Johnson County
